
HOME FOR SALE

The home is cedar sided and is on a concrete foundation. The home will have 100 amp service, a gas heating system and two small decks.

The Clear Light Community Management Company is offering this house for sale with the leased lot for \$90,000. This price includes the entire \$21,900 total cost for leasing a lot in the Clear Light Community.

Dear Members,

The Clear Light Community existed first as the visionary prototype of our Master Paramahansa Yogananda-- "the Yogoda World City."

He said, "The idea in creating the proposed Yogoda World City is to offer the war torn, industrially selfish, politically hidebound nations of the earth a glimpse of a perfect divine city...Swami Yogananda, with the help of a few exalted souls, is going to make a supreme effort to do something practical in establishing such a city."

In later years, he instructed one of these "exalted souls," Yogacharya Oliver, to establish a "retreat away from the city" where a "World Brotherhood Colony" could be established.

To this end, in 1970 Yogacharya Oliver founded Song of the Morning Ranch, located on 800 pristine acres surrounded by thousands of acres of state forest. A lifelong minister of Self-Realization Fellowship of Los Angeles, California, Yogacharya Oliver dedicated his life to fulfilling his Master's wishes. He instructed his Board of Directors in his last will and testament to establish the World Brotherhood Colony.

This instruction was carried out under Bob Raymer, current President and Spiritual Director of Song of the Morning and a devoted direct disciple of Paramahansa Yogananda. The Clear Light Community currently has 34 lots available for leasing, as well as another 32 lots that are being developed in Phase II of the project.

The pioneers of the project - those members who have already leased their lots - provided the financing to bring in roads, street signs, surveying, and electric power. Because of the Clear Light Community, the retreat was for the first time in its existence connected to the electric power grid in the year 2000.

However, much work remains to be done. Phone lines, both for the community and the retreat, the surveying and opening of Phase II, are next on the agenda.

To provide the funds needed to complete the community infrastructure this year, we are looking for 25 members who are willing to join with us and lease their lot in the Clear Light Community. Total cost remains \$21,900 per lease. This includes \$1,000 membership in the Community, \$5,000 lease price, and \$15,900 lease-hold improvement costs. Leases are for 50 years, renewable at no cost. They may be passed on to heirs or sold to approved members.

A new, no-interest payment plan is being offered until September 30, 2003 to make it easy for members to lease this year. Once the remaining infrastructure of the community is in place, houses will go up quickly, and the real community -- like-minded people living in peace, harmony and love -- will begin.

Then, all of us together will be those "pathfinders" who will create that "perfect divine city" envisioned by Master. Will you be one?

No interest payment plan available until September 30, 2003

For a limited time you may lease your lot in the Clear Light Community on a new no-interest payment plan.

This opportunity is being offered now to provide funds to bring in phone lines this year, as well as to move ahead with roads, surveying, and zoning necessary to open Phase II and honor our commitment to those who have already leased there.

The offer will be available to the first 25 members, or until September 30, 2003, whichever comes first.

A lot may be chosen in Phase I of the community, or you may get in line for lot choice in Phase II. Lot choice in both Phases is strictly on a first-come first-serve basis. No exceptions. Those choosing lots in Phase I of the community will, at closing, receive a Leasehold Owners Policy from Lawyers Title Insurance Corporation showing title to the leasehold estate and a legal description, which is filed with Otsego County. Those choosing lots in Phase II, while getting in line for a lot choice, will not be able to close on the lots until we complete the surveying, roads and final zoning necessary to open Phase II. Your loans will help us complete the work quickly.

Two options are offered. You may make a down payment of \$4,000 and then monthly payments of \$186.45 for 8 years. Or, you may make a down payment of \$2000 with monthly payments of \$207.30 for eight years.

If you are able to make the higher down or full payment of the lot this will help us greatly in moving ahead. Total cost to lease is \$21,900.

Those taking advantage of this plan may choose their lot now. However, they must finish paying for the lot before their home can be built on it. Nonpayment of loan will result in recision of lease.

Five members have already committed to leasing a lot on this plan. That leaves only 20 more opportunities, if this is the way you would like to lease.

By leasing and becoming a part of the World Brotherhood Colony, you will become a family member in Golden Lotus retreat life on your own little piece of Paradise.

It is our joy to make this exceptional plan available to you. Copies of the lease, rules and regulations, a disclosure statement and membership form, as well as further information are available from Richard or Carol Armour at 989-732-1092.

CAN YOU LIVE IN THE CITY AND BE HEALTHY? by Don Handyside

To answer this question let's look at what produces health. Each cell in the body is a tiny battery. The positive pole is energetically fed by oxygen. The negative pole is fed by photon energy from the sun stored in food. We are really sustained by oxygen and light. The importance of oxygen was recently underscored by a long-term study with thousands of people in Framingham MA. The study showed that the most accurate predictor of longevity is lung capacity. Now, consider the fact that in some cities the oxygen level is 35% lower than in the country, and ask yourself if being deprived of adequate oxygen seven days a week, twenty four hours a day could have an effect on your level of health and vitality.

In the Yoga Sutras, the Sage Pantanjali said that from pranayama, pratyahara, dharana, dhyana and samadhi will all happen spontaneously. That is to say as life force in the body begins to flow it will naturally internalize, concentrate, produce spontaneous meditation and eventually lead to samadi. It can truly be said that health and spiritual development are directly related to energy flow. As yogis we know for sure that energy does not flow when we are tense and stressed. Now, think of the level of stress and tension in the city and ask yourself if city life is conducive to physical or spiritual well being. Also, ask yourself if, in view of world events, the level of stress in the cities is likely to go up or down in the future.

Like most people who knew Yogacharya, I was inspired by the level of health and vitality he was able to achieve and maintain even into his nineties. I was also intrigued when he said that people of this century would have significantly longer lifespans. As I've looked at what it takes to produce an exceptional level of health, one thing has become apparent. While nutrition and exercise are necessary, if you are to be truly healthy, you need to live in an environment that is conducive to health. As this fact became obvious, I made the decision to begin to build a home at the Ranch by the summer of '04.

All this makes perfect sense you may say, but you can't leave the city just yet. Well take heart my friend, imagine how much easier you will breath and how much more relaxed you would be just knowing that you have your very own place on the Ranch to build your new life far away from the chaos of the city. And just think that this can happen by simply picking a lot and paying a small down payment with very reasonable monthly payments.

Ask yourself what would it be worth to live in a place where you could achieve optimal health and the kind of vitality that could increase your lifespan and hasten your progress in yoga. If you do ask yourself this question, I believe you will make the same choice I did. My only suggestion to you is not to hesitate, lots are going fast.
