



MANAGERS REPORT

The last couple of years has brought brave and idealistic men and women to the Clear Light Community, a "World Brotherhood" community as encouraged by Paramahansa Yogananda. The building was somewhat frenzied during 2021 and 2022, with supply chain shortages in building materials and labor shortages in transportation, manufacturing, and building.

Although costs have since stabilized, they have risen in the past few years, and new construction prices are unlikely to lessen much due to high demand. If your new home has to be financed and you already have a home free of debt, a home equity loan is a fairly simple way to finance your new home. If you sell your existing home, you can pay off the home equity loan after building your new house if you wish and be free of debt. If you choose a construction loan, it is usually a two-step process. After the home is complete, a new conventional mortgage is given.

Living in the Clear Light Community presents many opportunities to join in the development of our "Yoga Retreat of Excellence" with your skills and abilities. Among our newer residents, community members have been helping cook meals for guests at the Retreat, working with staff, getting involved with building projects, working on Archive material, focusing on health and wellness, and generally joining in with earlier residents already deeply involved in maintaining the Retreat. To work for God is a special joy all of its own.

Come and enjoy the roads upgraded with gravel throughout the Community, and check out the new Garden in Phase III, or take a walk to the new Shrine dedicated last summer by Naren in the future Cottage Industry Area. As we grow, the need for a Community Center becomes more obvious. During our recent open meeting in March, we shared different ideas and designs for the Center and will continue to focus on the final design in the next year or two.

It is amazing how much activity is going on in this "vortex of spiritual energy" started by Yogacharya. Membership continues to grow, and you are invited to grow with us, Come to Community Day on Saturday. July 1, and join in!

The Clear Light Community Association Committee met recently on March 4, 2023, after being relatively inactive for several years. The Clear Light Community Association comprises all leaseholders, which the CLCA Committee represents. The committee has existed for over ten years and has become more active with recent meetings in November and March. The Association Committee is separate from the Clear Light Community Management Company (CLCMC).

The committee members are Steve Sandner (president), Wendy Page-Echols, Angela Lentine (secretary), Steve Zawisa, Joe Stermer, Tom Wright, John Pfluecke, and Michael Krumpelt.

At the March 4 meeting, we set a Community Zoom meeting for ALL LEASEHOLDERS on June 24, 2023. The time for the meeting was tentatively set for 10:30 AM. We will send out email announcements and reminders. Information will be posted on the website at **SOMCommunity.com**.

After mentioning it at our last meeting, Wendy talked about her starting a "Happy Camper" program where the Community sponsors a variety of activities on a monthly basis. The first event took place on February 13 at the Main House, with a variety of games, and staff was invited to join. Wendy reported that it was a resounding success!

The committee also talked about safety concerns within the Community and the Retreat. At least three of our committee members are trained in CPR, and one or two committee members could be certified to teach CPR soon. We talked about ensuring everyone is aware of the first aid kit in the mainhouse. Also, we noted that a wellness committee has already been established among Community members outside of our committee. We also discussed the importance of the red folder, which every home has on top of their refrigerator, containing emergency contact information and other information related to the Community.

The committee discussed other Community issues and interests, including the Phase III garden, which is mainly being handled thus far by the CLCMC board. Gift baskets and other logistics for our board membership and structure were discussed. 

This beautiful music CD contains songs that were previously sung and performed at The Detroit Institute of Arts when Yogacharya served there as SRF minister and Kriya Yoga initiator. Of course, this includes many chants and songs from Paramahansa Yogananda's Cosmic Chants collection, as well as the songs "My God and I" and "O Master Let Me Walk With Thee," which were often part of Yogacharya's SRF services.

Peggy Braden is featured on the CD as a solo vocalist, and Steve Sandner provides accompaniment on piano and organ.

Steve and Peggy met in Ann Arbor and first informally performed together at Song of the Morning. Yogacharya was there working on a recording project with Marilyn Beker, and Peggy and Steve were asked to provide the project with some music and songs from Cosmic Chants. The first recordings were made in 1971 at a large recording studio at the University of Michigan, with Marilyn as producer and Steve playing pipe organ. Marilyn, Peggy, and Steve had several rehearsals at Yogacharya's home on Parkside Ave in Detroit. For Peggy and Steve, this was to be their first time in a professional recording studio. With high anticipation, and some nervousness, Marilyn, Peggy, and Steve met at the University in Marilyn's car to get final instructions for the recording. Peggy and Steve remember that Marilyn led a brief meditation and read from Whispers From Eternity!

During gatherings at the Ranch throughout the years, Peggy and Steve were often asked by Yogacharya to perform chants and other songs together.

Peggy and Steve then did more recordings for Yogacharya with Jed MacKay as producer. The recordings with Jed were part of Yogacharya's Whispers From Eternity series released on cassette in the early 1980s. These music recording sessions with Marilyn and Jed turned out wonderfully, and we hope to release these recordings in the future.

Owing to Marilyn's and Jed's professionalism, Peggy and Steve used the same approach to produce their own recordings in the mid-1990s in Chicago. These Chicago sessions provided most of the tracks on the "Door of My Heart" CD. Special thanks to Matt Wolfe, who had digitized these audio files and helped spur the project when he contacted us.

As these song recordings were being compiled to be produced on a CD release, Self-Realization Fellowship was kept apprised of our progress, and we deeply appreciate their encouragement!

The final track of the CD, "O Master Let Me Walk With Thee," was recorded in the domes at Song of the Morning, using Yogacharya's Chickering piano. This beautiful Christian hymn is still sung at the end of Sunday services at Song of the Morning.

what you believe in."



PRACTICES AND STEPS LEADING TO SPIRITUAL EVOLUTION

(Commentary during SRF Meditation Service at the Detroit Institute of Arts, March 31, 1968)



Now, as we get ready for our devotional meditation,

let us all sit upright in our seats, spines straight, shoulder blades together, backs of the hands lying at the junction between the thighs and the abdomen, chin level, placing the feet flat on the floor, touching each other. And then lean slightly forward for balance. Yoga requires the right posture, which will enable one to go deeper in meditation than he could do otherwise. So, following the yoga meditation techniques, then concentrate the attention at the mid spot between the eyebrows. Let the mind think of yourself, focusing your eyes there. Now lift your eyes, but not cross-eyed, so you see a shadow of your own eyebrows, then think with the mind of the mid spot between the eyebrows, so your eyes will have the right posture. You see this posture portrayed by Hoffman the great artist in Jesus in Gethsemane. You'll see that picture in the Art Institute. That famous painting. In that eye posture of the great Master, you see a teardrop in both of his eyes. In those great men of Self-Realization, they have some particular characteristic that shows the depth of their wisdom and understanding and their place in human evolution, which we all have to pass through sooner or later before we are allowed to enter the higher grades of realization.

It is just like we being in the third grade; we have the fourth, fifth, sixth, and seventh grades. And after we've been in the fourth grade, no one wants to go back to the first or second grade, neither do we want to stay in the third grade, that we are in right now in evolution. But we have to work our way up the ladder of Self-Realization by self-effort and learning how to live our lives in order to enable us to pass beyond this third-dimensional consciousness into the fourth dimension; In the third dimension, we have length, breadth, and thickness, but in the fourth dimension, that is when we see everything from all sides at the same time. That is when the soul is said to have a thousand eyes. We see everywhere in every direction all at the same time.

So as long as we are dependent on looking through a couple of little slits in our head, we call our "eyes," our spirit is being imprisoned in the prison of the physical body, in the tomb of the physical body. By meditation, we can free ourselves from your body prison and become omnipresent, with the great omnipresence of God. And when you pass beyond the darkness of your own mind, just behind the darkness of your own mind is that dimension of light. And then you will realize what is going on in evolution when you learn how to meditate deeply enough so that you are enabled through your own self-discipline to control your body so that you will be allowed to escape from it. You will find yourself in the freedom of all that there is, and then you can look back and see your little physical body sitting right where you are. I can tell you that is the truth because it happened to me many times; my Master taught me in meditation how to do it. You will know because you know. And that is what we are supposed to do in this physical existence, is to know because we do know. And then, you will be able to look around the world about you and see what kind of condition it is in spiritually, which in this age is very bad, very poor. But it will all come out of the depth of darkness, and souls will evolve into that great consciousness of light, and everything will change if we make a spiritual effort now.

Day by day, as you learn to meditate, a new awareness will come, and a new living relationship with God will be established. The mist of silence and mystery that hangs over everything will slowly vanish before the dawning light of your mental and devotional search for God.
